WE NEED YOUR SUPPORT

The average cost of a heart transplant is \$1.4 Million. Caring for a Heart Failure patient costs almost \$30,000/year in the US. The average cost for a singular Heart Failure-specific hospitalization is \$13,400. Yet, the average annual income of a heart transplant recipient is only \$50,000.

The need to support patients with Heart Failure, VADs, and heart transplants is so incredibly important. Financial projections for LVAD (Left Ventricular Assist Device) and transplant procedures show no sign of slowing. Proudly, we have never been in an oversubscribed position. DETAILS

Cost: A mere fraction of the cost of downtown Boston area hotels.

Lead-Time: If there is vacancy, rooms can be filled within 24 hours notice.

Payment: 100% payment for the full length of stay is due at the time of booking. We accept credit card payments via our online booking system.

Check-In: After 4 pm

Check-Out: By 10:30 am

Occupancy: 5 person maximum

Pets: Not permitted



ELIGIBILITY

- Patients must have a Heart Failure, LVAD, or heart transplant diagnosis.
- Patients must be receiving treatment at one of the Boston-area Heart Failure / LVAD / Transplant Centers for their diagnosis or have appointments/testing there related to that diagnosis.
- Patients receiving outpatient treatment are required to have a treatment schedule. Please see our website for more details.
- There must be a need for accommodations for a minimum 3-night and maximum 30-night stay as long as the patient continues to meet our eligibility criteria.
- Guests must not have any infectious disease (cold, flu, COVID).



APPLY

Patients must have a diagnosis of Heart Failure. Patients, caregivers, and/or loved ones are all welcome to apply.

To request accommodations, contact your hospital's social work department and request a referral. Please note: a referral is not a guarantee of stay and will be accepted on a first-come-first-served basis. Once the referral is approved, our HeartBrothers House staff will reach out to you to book or waitlist your room according to availability at that time.
